



PATIENT OBLIGATIONS

Patients receiving healthcare services at the Pope John Paul II Independent Public Provincial Hospital in Zamość are required to comply with the rules arising from applicable laws and regulations, and in particular:

- 1) a patient is required to follow all recommendations and instructions given by doctors and nurses/midwives.
- 2) a patient must not take any medication or undergo any procedures without the recommendation of the attending physician or the physician on duty,
- 3) it is prohibited to bring in or consume alcoholic beverages or smoke tobacco products on Hospital premises.

A patient is also required to:

- 1) remain in the designated patient room during medical visits, procedures, and dressing changes, as well as at mealtimes,
- 2) adhere to standards of social behaviour, and respect for the dignity and privacy of other patients,
- 3) respect the Hospital's property,
- 4) inform the medical staff of their intention to leave the ward.
